

BELLA-PERENNIS

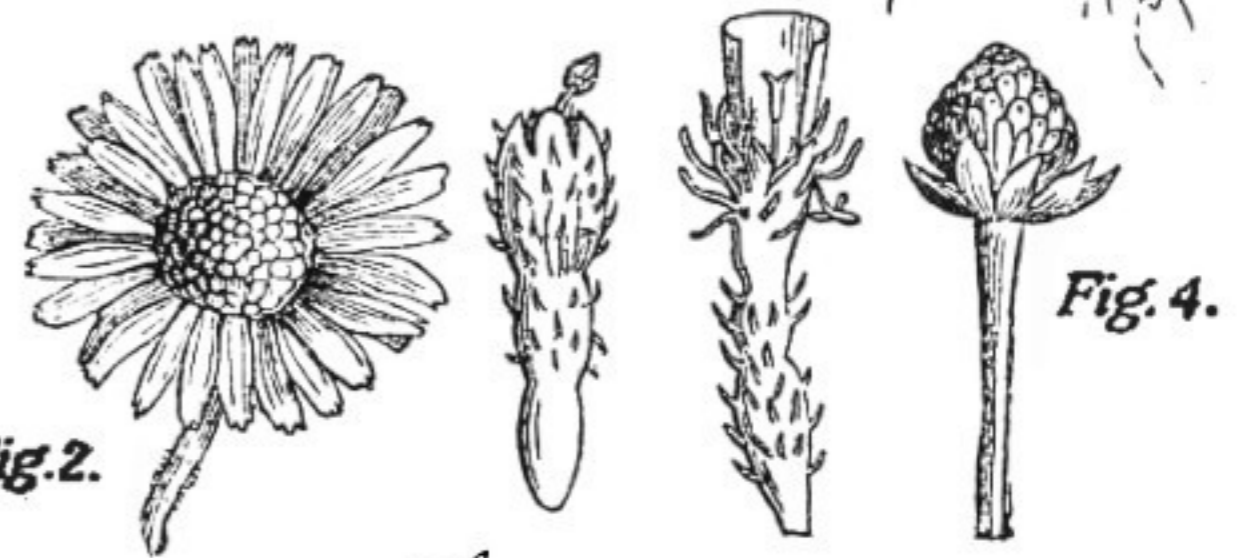
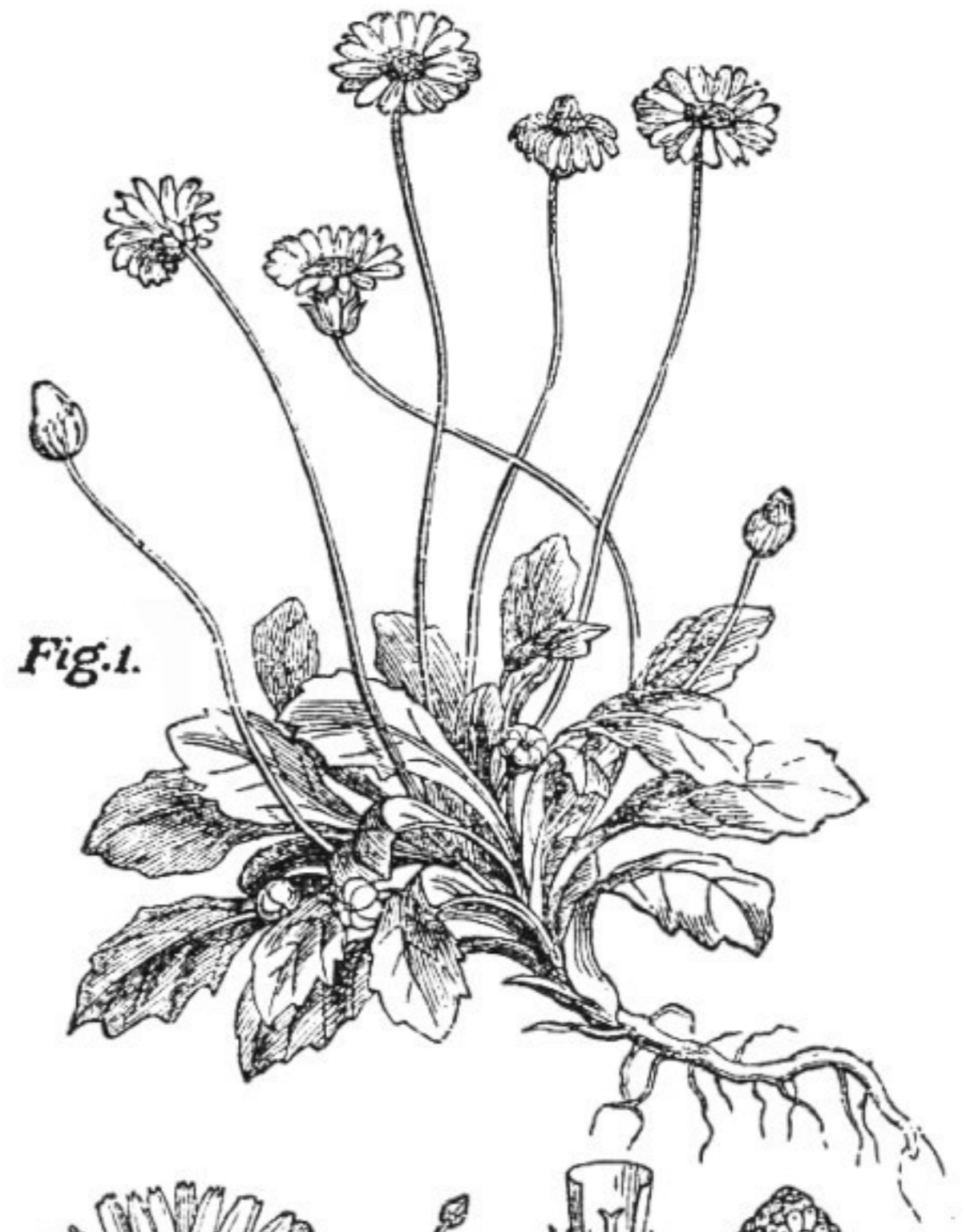
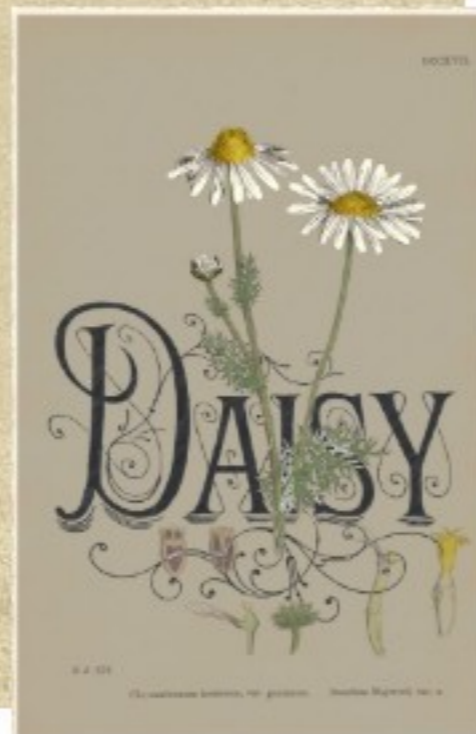
(English Daisy)
